The following are a sampling of the CPT* codes frequently used by speech-language pathology practitioners to report services in various settings. Not all codes available to SLP practitioners are listed. It is the responsibility of the practitioner to be aware of coding changes and to bill for services accordingly. *Note that not all codes are accepted by all payers, and state regulations may have limitations on the codes that can be utilized. 15-Minute Codes

For CPT codes designated as 15 minutes, multiple coding represents minimum face-to-face treatment, as follows.

> 1 unit: 8 minutes to <23 minutes 2 units: 23 minutes to <38 minutes 3 units: 38 minutes to <53 minutes 4 units: 53 minutes to <68 minutes 5 units: 68 minutes to <83 minutes 6 units: 83 minutes to <98 minutes

Example, a 35 minute cognitive treatment might be billed 97129 for the first unit, and 97130 for the 2nd unit.
